ICANN Final Determination

Re: Notice of Registry Operator Request for Termination of Registry Agreement - .iselect

On 31 March 2019, iSelect Ltd [notified ICANN org](#) of its intent to terminate the .iselect Registry Agreement entered into on 11 February 2015. Pursuant to Section 4.4(b) of the Registry Agreement, Registry Operator may terminate the Registry Agreement for any reason upon one hundred eighty (180) calendar day advance notice.

Pursuant to the terms of Section 4.5 of the Registry Agreement (as modified by Section 6 of Specification 13 for this .Brand TLD), ICANN org consulted with iSelect Ltd to assess whether to transition operation of the .iselect top-level domain (TLD) to a successor Registry Operator.

On 03 June 2019, ICANN org made a [preliminary determination](#) that operation of the .iselect TLD need not be transitioned to a successor Registry Operator based on the following rationale:

1. .iselect qualifies as a .Brand TLD.
2. Transitioning the TLD is not necessary to protect the public interest.

On 03 July 2019, after a 30-day period for comments by interested parties, no comments were received. Pursuant to Section 4.4(b) of the Registry Agreement, ICANN org will proceed to terminate the .iselect Registry Agreement by 27 September 2019.

In conformance with Section 4.5 of the Registry Agreement (as modified by Section 6 of Specification 13 for this .Brand TLD), ICANN org may not delegate the TLD to a successor registry operator for a period of two years without Registry Operator's consent, which shall not be unreasonably withheld, conditioned or delayed.
