This letter is to inform you that ICANN has approved PIR's proposed amendment to implement One and Two-Character Name Allocation in .org, in accordance with the Registry Services Evaluation Policy and process set forth at <http://www.icann.org/registries/rsep/rsep.html>.

ICANN's preliminary determination did not identify any significant competition or security and stability issues. Furthermore, similar requests have been approved for other gTLD registries.

PIR may proceed with the allocation of One and Two-Character Names based upon this framework.
