

## **Amendment No. 2 to Registry Agreement**

The Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers and Over Keep, LLC agree, effective as of \_\_\_\_\_ (“Amendment No. 2 Effective Date”), that the modification set forth below is made to the 31 March 2016 **.SHOPPING** Registry Agreement between the parties (“Agreement”).

The parties hereby agree to amend Exhibit A by deleting the following section in its entirety:

### **“6. "Blocked Names”**

- 6.1. Registry operator may offer the "Blocked Names" service, which is a registry service that allows trademark rights holders to register domain names based on the labels listed in a valid SMD issued by an ICANN-authorized trademark validator.
- 6.2. Registry Operator must offer registrars support for the "Blocked Names" service in EPP.
- 6.3. Domain names registered using the "Blocked Names" service must be registered through a registrar and reported to ICANN as any other transaction.
- 6.4. The "Blocked Names" service must be disabled for a specific domain name when requested by the sponsoring Registrar.
- 6.5. Domain names registered using the "Blocked Names" service may be activated for the purpose of displaying a web page stating that the domain name has been registered as a "Blocked Name".

The parties hereby further agree to amend Exhibit A by replacing the deleted section above with new text as a new section 6.:

### **“6. Domains Protected Marks List (DPML)**

The DPML is a service that allows trademark rights holders to block certain labels from registration across multiple TLDs operated by the Registry Operator. The blocked names must comply with the provisions described in Specification 5, Section 3.3 of the Registry Agreement. Domain Names blocked by the DPML service will be either an exact match of a label or will contain an exact match of such labels, or may include domain names that are a misspelling or contain a misspelling of a label. Blocked labels do not prevent other trademark rights holders from unblocking the label and registering the domain name.”

The parties agree that, except as set forth in this Amendment, the current terms and conditions of the Agreement will remain in full force and effect. All capitalized terms not defined will have the meaning given to them in the Agreement.
