RE: IPC Submission to ICANN CEO re: Models for GDPR Compliance

Dear Mr. Winterfeldt,

Thank you for your letter of 13 January 2018. It has been published to our correspondence page [here](#).

As you know, we have received more than [60 comments](#) from across the community regarding the [three ICANN-proposed interim models](#) for compliance with the European Union's General Data Protection Regulation. These comments have also touched upon proposed models and suggestions from the community.

As I noted in our [2 Feb. 2018 webinar](#), the ICANN-proposed models, the community-proposed models and discussions, communications from the range of participants in the comments received, information from the Hamilton analyses, will all be considered to determine a final interim model. In doing so, and in light of the input offered, variations or modifications to one of the ICANN-proposed models may be identified for the path forward.

With this input in mind, on 28 February 2018, we posted a [proposed interim compliance model](#) for community input. We welcome your feedback on this model, as we work toward settled on the final interim model.

We look forward to continuing these discussions with you and other community members over the coming weeks, including at the ICANN61 meeting in San Juan.
