| Claimant recommends that Panelists have significant expertise regarding (1) the domain name system; (2) ICANN's mission, work, policies, practices, and procedures; and (3) international law, corporate governance, judicial systems, alternative dispute resolution and/or arbitration. |

In the submission, state specifically the grounds under which the claimant has the standing and the right to assert this claim. For the purposes of the Independent Review Process (IRP), demonstration of standing requires the claimant to, in specific and particular details, dent fy how t has been directly impacted and material by an CANN Board decision, and not by the actions of third parties. Material harm requires that there must be a loss or injury suffered (financial or non-financial) that is a directly and causally connected to the Board violation of the By aws or Articles of incorporation on which the complaint is based. The decision of the RP Pane (as reviewed and acted upon by the Board) must be able to stop the harm. In urgoin harm caused by third parties as a result of acting in new with the Board's decision is not a sufficient ground for Independent Review. Similarly, injury or harm that is only of a sufficient magnitude because it was exacerbated by the actions of a third party is also not a sufficient ground for an Independent Review.

By submitting this Notice, Claimant acknowledges the following:

Wr tten subm ss ons of argument to the RP Pane are m ted to 25 pages, doub e spaced and n 12 point font.

The Char of the standing pane for the RP retains the ability to decide on what the appropriate size of the pane will be, based upon ssues such as the complexity of the matter alleged. The Char may also make recommendations of whether any particular expertise is desired on the Pane in the event the standing pane is not yet comprised, the CDR will assist in determining the appropriate size of the pane and the particular expertise that is recommended for the pane.

The RP Pane sha have the power to d sm ss the request summar y n the event the calmant cannot demonstrate standing to initiate the proceeding. The RP Pane sha also have the power to d sm ss fr volumes or vexatious requests.

f the cammant has not availed tise f, in good faith, of the cooperative engagement or conciliation at on process and CANN is the prevaining party in the RP, the RP Panel must award CANN a reasonable fees and costs incurred by CANN in the RP, including legal fees.

The ICANN Board's decision following on from the Declaration of the IRP Panel is final and creates precedent for future IRP proceed ngs. If the subject matter of the request is on the same as a prior in RP Panel is final and creates precedent for future IRP proceedings. If the subject matter of the request is on the same as a prior in RP Panel is binding and serves as grounds for summary dismissal of the request for independent Review.
