

2017 Nominating Committee Report Card #2

February 2017

Since being seated in Hyderabad, the 2017 ICANN Nominating Committee (NC2017) has been focusing on putting out its call for applications, doing outreach and preparing for its next face-to-face meeting in Copenhagen, at ICANN #58.

NC2017 Call for Applications

NC2017's call for applications went out on January 11, 2017:

Deadline for applications is March 21, 2017.

This year's NomCom is recruiting to the following positions:

- Two members of the ICANN Board of Directors
- Three At-Large Advisory Committee (ALAC) representatives (one each from Africa, Asia/Australia/Pacific Islands and Latin America/Caribbean regions)
- Two members of the Council of the Generic Names Supporting Organization (GNSO)
- One member of the Council of the Country-Code Names Supporting Organization (ccNSO)

NC2017 outreach

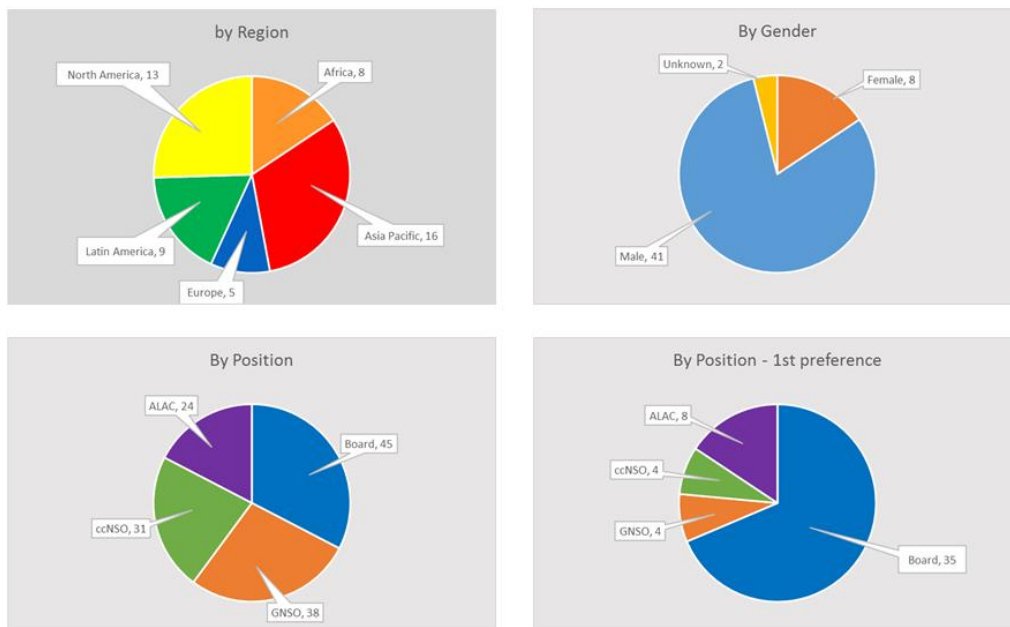
Outreach is extremely important at this stage of the NC2017 process, as the NomCom strives to connect with as many prospective applicants as possible.

The NomCom's Outreach Sub Committee is looking at a number of events where NC2017 members could attend and do outreach.

Outreach is also being done by individual NC2017 members. One attended a DNS Training session in Venezuela in January and explained how the NomCom works to over 170 people. The NC2017 is attending a domain event in Bulgaria in February and will present on the NomCom there. Other initiatives and events are also planned.
