2017 Nominating Committee Report Card #4

June 2017

At publication of this report card, the 2017 NomCom has entered the most rigorous and work-intensive part of its cycle. Through numerous calls and extensive polling, analyzing, deep diving and rounds of discussion, the NomCom has evaluated and ranked the pool of candidates for the many positions the committee is charged with selecting.

The NomCom now prepares to go into its final face-to-face meeting of the year, at ICANN 59 in Johannesburg at the end of June, to interview candidates and complete its final selection.

This report card presents some key numbers for the 2017 cycle prior to the final selection.

NC2017 Call for Applications

A reminder of the main data about the 2017 application period:

This year's NomCom has been recruiting for the following positions:

- Two members of the ICANN Board of Directors
- Three At-Large Advisory Committee (ALAC) representatives (one each from Africa, Asia/Australia/Pacific Islands and Latin America/Caribbean regions)
- Two members of the Council of the Generic Names Supporting Organization (GNSO)
- One member of the Council of the Country-Code Names Supporting Organization (ccNSO)

Deadline for applications was March 21, 2017 and for completion of submissions on Mar 30, 2017.

Statistics on the committee's work

From April 12 to June 14, the NomCom held 9 teleconference calls, which is approximately 1,260 minutes or 21 hours of assessment work.

Next steps

In Johannesburg, the NomCom will interview candidates shortlisted for the ICANN and PTI Boards.

Following these interviews and committee discussion, the NomCom will hold its selection meeting and agree on its final slate.
