Current Audit State

Audits delivered to-date are focused in the following areas of:

- Whois Access Audit
- Whois Data Reminder Policy (WDRP) Audit
- Registrar Website Audit
- Inter Registrar Transfer Policy (IRTP) Audit

Future Audit State

Audits will be delivered based on audit strategy, methodology, and approach:

- Three-Year Audit Plan
- Audit Scope focused on agreements and policies
- Standard Operating Process and Procedure
- Sampling Methodology
- Additional Follow Up Reviews When Necessary

Goal of the Audit Program

To allow ICANN to properly manage, audit, and remediate deficiencies of all contracted parties to ensure alignment and compliance with their contractual obligations.

Overall Approach

- To conduct an audit of contracted parties in a well defined methodology, process and timeline
- To review audit results and request further evidence to cure deficiencies discovered
- To identify and action non-compliant contracted parties, while overseeing remediation efforts
- To enforce additional compliance activities of various contracts when issues are not resolved

Audit Scope

- The contract (agreement) and consensus policies
- ICANN accredited registrars with 2001 and 2009 RAA
- ICANN registries with 2001 Registry Agreement(s)
- Scope will expand to include new gTLD

Three Year Audit Plan

Each Registry and Registrar agreement will be randomly selected for audit over a three-year period.

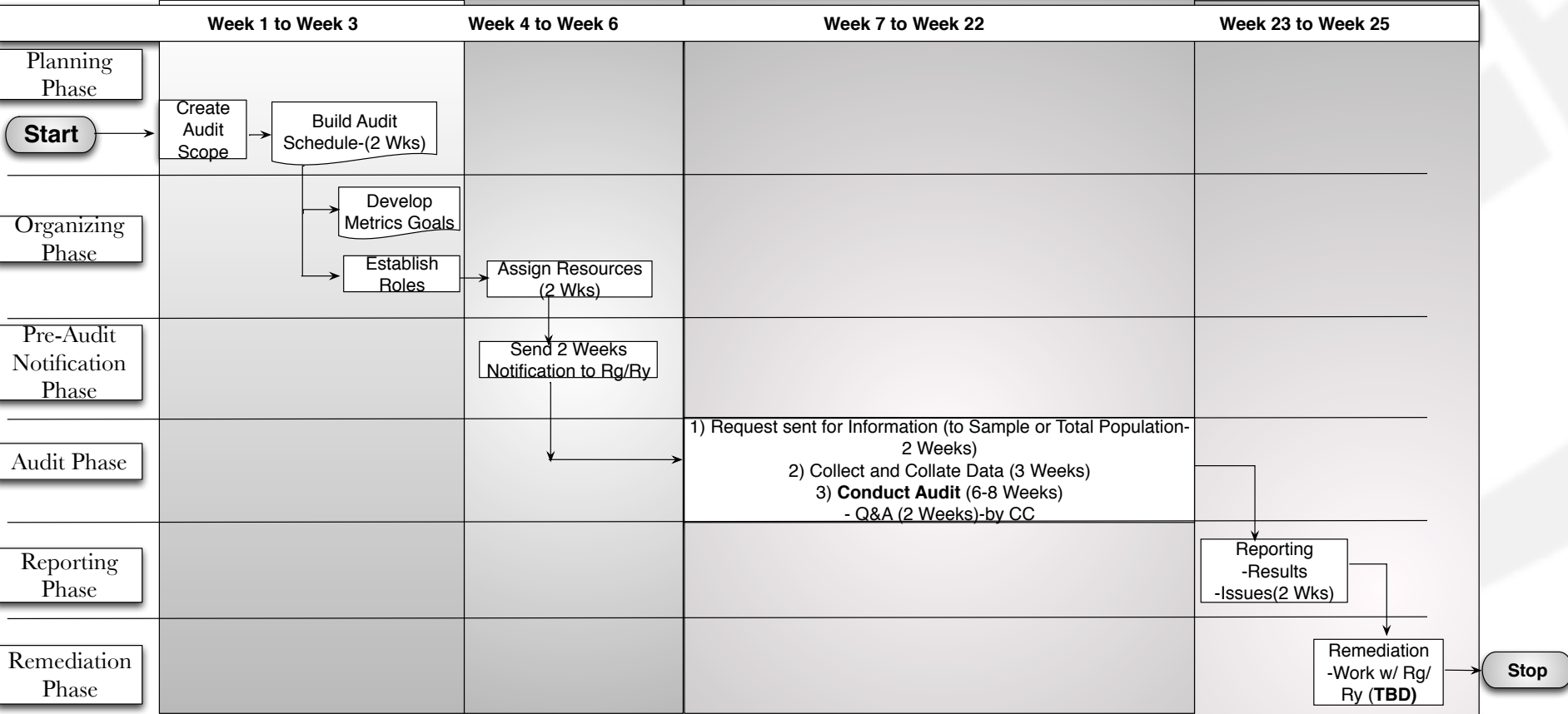
- Year one, 1/3rd of Registry and Registrar Agreements
- Year two, another 1/3rd from the remaining list
- Year three, the remaining 1/3rd of all contracted parties

- New gTLD Registries and other new agreements will roll into the audit plan

Note: Registrars and Registries may be subject to additional audit(s) based on circumstances or considerations.
